

POST OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR ROOT CANAL TREATMENT (RCT)

- Root Canal Treatment can take at least 2 or 3 appointments depending on each case.
- You may experience any of the following symptoms after your RCT appointment: moderate pain, sensitivity to pressure, possible swelling etc. It may take a few days for these symptoms to subside gradually.
- If prescribed medication please take as directed by your dentist
- A temporary filling may be used to seal the tooth between visits. Please be gentle on the tooth while eating until the final restoration is placed.
- After RCT the tooth becomes more brittle and prone to fracture. In most cases a **CROWN** is advised to prevent further damage to the tooth.
